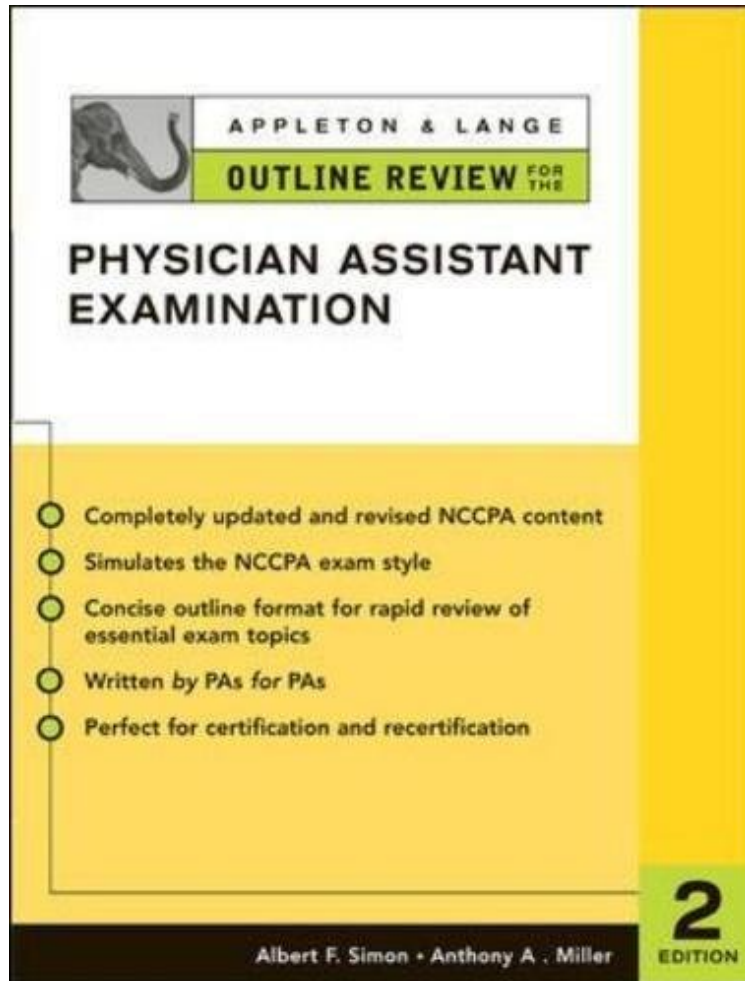

I'm glad I bought both books because the outline review although accurate seems incomplete. A lot of material in the practice test book is not covered in the outline review. By the way, page 556 suggests Charcot's triad is flank pain, abdominal mass, and hematuria of a kidney mass. But all I have found regarding Charcot's triad is that it's fever, jaundice, and right upper quadrant pain from an infected obstruction of the common bile duct.
