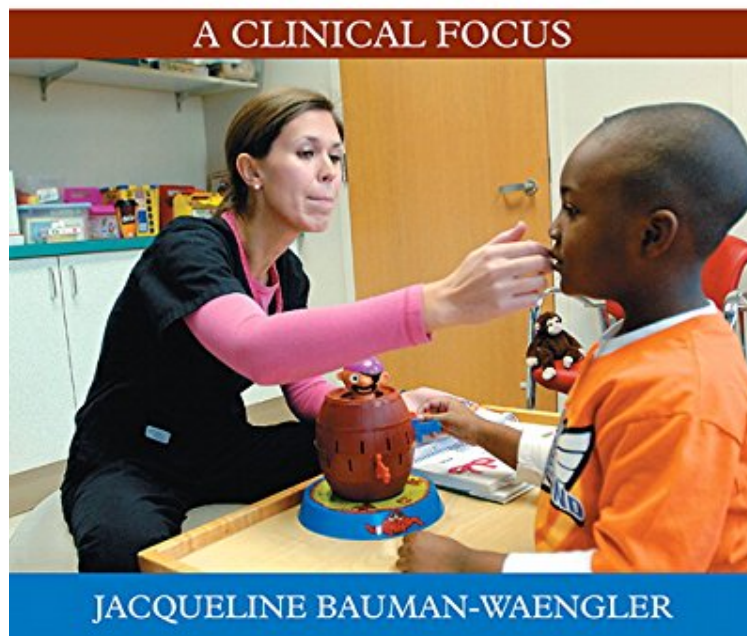

The binding is already showing wear after less than 3 months of use. It looks as though they have simply printed an online book because some of the text runs right up to the edges of the pages, and it's not even in color. Pages are thin and highlighter immediately bleeds through. All that might be overlooked if the text itself were good, but I find it a little hard to trust because I have found several typos and factual mistakes in many

of the tables and figures. This book will not be a good reference for future as I hardly know if it will survive the semester.
