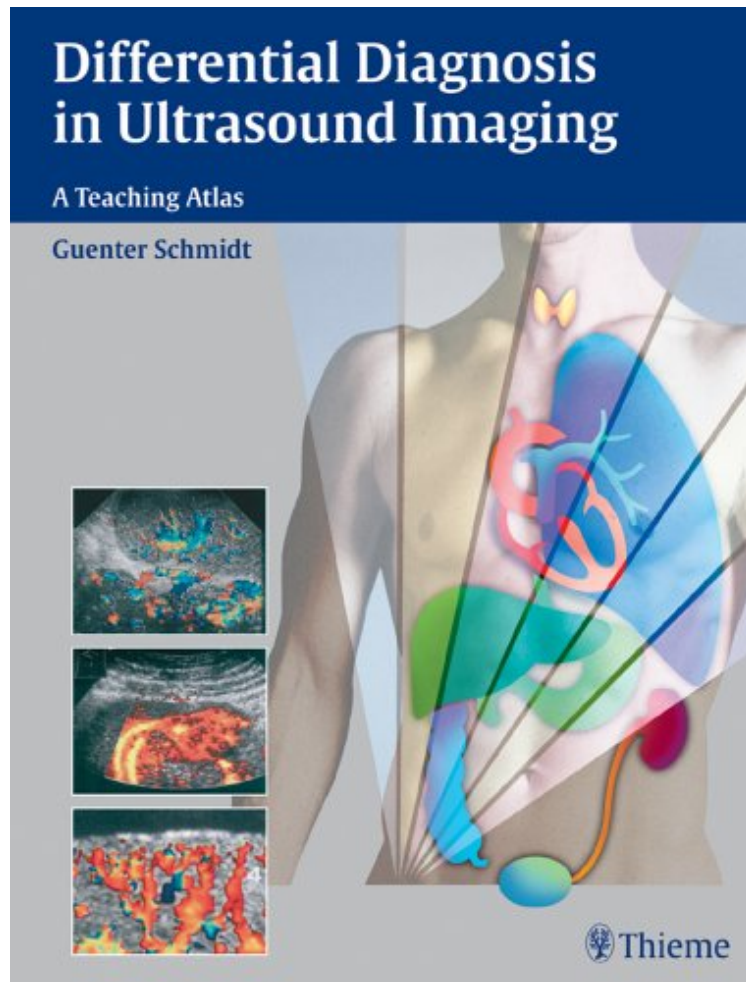

First thing I found is this book does not include neither transrectal nor transvaginal ultrasound. Secondly, as soon as I started to read, found one important mistake: page 376, fig 12.22, referring to Purulent vesiculitis where it says: "intensely echogenic seminal vesicles in a patient with suppurative pyelonephritis. " You can clearly see those seminal vesicles are almost anechoic, as you should expect for vesiculitis.
